

CHAPTER 1

Introduction

District at a Glance

Background: In the fag end of the seventh century A.D Wan Chiang – a Chinese traveler came to Samata (in ancient time the south eastern part of Bengal was called Samata Empire). This has been stated in his travelogue. He mentioned a place named Koa Molska in his travelogue published in Chinese. According to his description this place was known to be situated on the bank of the sea to the east-southern part of Samata. The historians opine this place which is mentioned in Wan Chiang's book as Kia Molski predominantly occupied by the Brahmanities is known as Komolaska and today's Comilla (Comilla).

In the old days, Tripura now Comilla under Samata was ruled by Gupta dynasty before fourth century A.D. Gupta Empire was in power over Samata before 507-508 A.D. In the 7th century A.D Buddhist region and culture of Comilla, pagoda, buddist priests, ruling dynasties and loknath dynasty have been depicted from the citations of Khargo and Loknath dynasties. The Royal dynasty of Samatata of 7th century A.D ruled during the middle of the century and during the 9th century the Buddhist rulers reigned Comilla. After the fall of Khargo dynasty Buddhist Ved came into being in the Samata. After this the Barman dynasty ruled the samata during the last quarter of 11th century to middle of 12th century. The Sen dynasty ruled Samata from 1097 to 1230 A.D. Laxan Sen was the last powerful emperor. After this Iktiaruddin Mohammad Bakhtiar Khalji invaded Bengal and initiated the Muslim rule here Ampale information are available on the British rule during 1765-1920 A.D. In 1618 AD Ibrahim Khan Fatehjong, the Subeder of Mughal Emperor Jahangir conquered Udaypur the capital of Tripura by defeating Jashodhar Manikya.

In 1732 this region is named Chakla Rowshanabad meaning the residence of light. The region came under the Company rule when the East India Company obtained Dewany from the Mughals. Comilla region was at that time under the rule of Naib-e-Najim and Naib-e-Dewan of Emperor Jahangir. At that time Rowshanabad was divided into 24 Pargans. Besides a total area of 528 square miles including 426 square miles of Comilla and 102 square miles of Noakhali was under Rowshanabad Chakla. In 1793 the boundary of Tripura district was modified and in 1821 Noakhali Collectorate was established with the region of southern Tripura. In 1860 A.D Nasir Nagar Sub-division (subsequently B'Baria Sub-division) and 1878 A.D Chandpur Sub-division were created. The inhabitants of Comilla participated in the Sepoy Movement and Swadeshi Movement. The socio-economic condition of Comilla improved further when the undivided Bengal came into being on 12 December, 1971. In 1974 when East Bengal had gone to Pakistan in the name of East Pakistan by breaking the undivided Bengal, the inhabitants of East Bengal, the inhabitants of East Bengal started to be deprived and exploited by the Pakistanis and lost everything. In 1971 East Bengal (East Pakistan) achieved independence through a liberation war and emerged Bangladesh as a new country. In the process of destroy and creation in geo-political scenario of this region, the position of Comilla was always enlightened.

Geographic Area and Location: Comilla District is bounded on the north by Brahmanbaria District, on the east by Tripura State of India, on the south by Feni and Noakhali Districts and on the west by Narayanganj District, Munshiganj and Chandpur Districts. It lies between 23°02' and 23°48' north latitudes and between 90°38' and 91°22' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 3146.30 sq. km. (1214.79 sq. miles) including 6.79 sq. km. forest area.

Administration: Comilla District was established as Tripura in 1790. It was renamed Comilla in 1960. The district consists of 16 upazilas, 181 unions, 2473 mauzas, 3532 villages, 10 paurashavas,

99 wards and 296 mahallas. The upazilas are Comilla Adarsha Sadar, Barura, Chandina, Daudkandi, Laksham, Brahmanpara, Burichang, Chaudhogram, Debidwar, Homna, Muradnagar, Titas, Comilla Sadar Dakshin, Monogarganj, Meghna and Nangalkot.

Township: Comilla City stands on the bank of the river Gumti. The total area of the city is 54.45 sq. km. Comilla City Corporation was formed on 10 July, 2011, consisting of 27 wards of Comilla Adarsha Sadar Paurashava and Comilla Sadar Dakshin Paurashava. In the suburb, there exists the Commonwealth War Cemetery Memorials, Muktijoddha Museum at Mainamati Cantonment, Bangladesh Academy for Rural Development (BARD), Mainamati Museum and Comilla Cadet College at Courtbari.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Marks of rich ancient civilization have been found in Lalmai Mainamati hills. In these hills there are plenty of archaeological sites including Shalvan Vihara, Kutila Mura, Charandra Mura, Rupban Mura, Itakhola Mura, Satera Ratna Mura, Ranir Banglar Pahar, Ananda Bazar Palaces, Palaces of Bhoj King, Chandi Mura, etc. Various archaeological relics including images and metallized utensils discovered from these viharas, muras and palaces are now preserved in the Mainamati Museum. Other archaeological heritage and relics include Saptaratna Mandir (Jagannath Mandir), Shah Suja Mosque, Dharmasagar, Chandimata Mandir (on the top of Lalmai Hill of Barura), Chandala Shiva Mandir (Brahmanpara, eighteenth century), Saitshala Jame Mosque (Brahmanpara, 1719), Mazars of Panch Pir (five saints) at Shashidal (Brahmanpara, 1815), Harimangal Math (Brahmanpara, 1822), Ramnagar elongated Math (Brahmanpara, 1705), Saitshala Rammahan Mandir (Brahmanpara, 1805), Hasnabad Math and Hatiabhang Fort (Daudkandi) are notable.

Historical Events: Peasants Movement against the king of Tripura in 1764 under the leadership of Samsher Gazi is a notable historical event. Communal tension spread over Comilla when a Muslim was shot at Comilla town during the Partition of Bengal in 1905. During the preparation of a countrywide Hartal on 21 November 1921, protesting the visit of India by Prince of Wales, Kazi Nazrul Islam composed patriotic songs and tried to awaken the town people. During this time Avay Ashram, as a revolutionary institution, played significant role. Rabindranath Tagore and Mahatma Gandhi visited Comilla at that time. In 1931, the British Gurkha soldiers fired indiscriminately and killed four persons of village Mohini of Chaudhogram upazila when about four thousand peasants of this village revolted against paying land revenue. In a huge peasant gathering the police fired at Hasnabad of Laksham Upazila in 1932. Two persons were killed and many wounded in this firing.

Marks of the War of Liberation: There are 5 mass killing sites located at Laksham, Comilla Cantonment, Homna, Beltali and Rasulpur; 8 Mass graves located at Betiara, Muzaffarganj, Nagaripara Cantonment, Krishnapur, Dhananjay, Dilabad and Laksham Bidi (Local Cigarette) Factory; 7 Memorials located at Comilla Victoria College, Beriara, Police Line, Cantonment, Laksham, Polytechnic Institution and Haratali which bear the testimony of the War of Liberation in Comilla District.

Famous Personalities: Comilla is the birthplace of many national and international personalities. Some of them are mentioned below:

- **Ajit Kumar Guha:** He was an educationist and an intellectual. He joined Jagannath College in 1948 as a professor of Bengali. He wrote many articles on literature, education and culture.
- **Buddhadeb Bosu:** He was a renowned Bengali writer of the 20th century though he completed his M.A. in English from Dhaka University with distinction marks. He was a versatile writer who wrote novels, short stories, plays and essays in addition to poetry. He was an influential critic and editor of his time. He is recognized as one of the five poets who moved to introduce modernity into Bengali Poetry. It has been said that since Tagore perhaps, there has been no greater talent in Bengali literature.
- **Major Abdul Gani:** He got emergency commission in the army as a second lieutenant and became lieutenant in 1942 and captain in 1943. Abdul Gani was promoted to the rank of honorary Major in 1953. He was one of the pioneers in forming the first East Bengal Regiment. After retirement, he joined politics and was elected a member of Provincial Assembly in 1954 as an independent candidate.
- **Nawab Faizunnesa Choudhurani:** She was a Zaminder of Homnabad-Pashchimgaon Estate in the present-day comilla district. She was most famous for her active role for the spread of female education and other social issues. She was awarded the title “Nawab” in 1889 as the recognition of her social work by the Queen of England.
- **Sachin Dev Burman:** Sachin Dev Burman was a famous music composer and was also popularly known as S.D.Burman. He was one of the most well-renowned Bollywood music directors. S D Burman composed music for 100 movies, including Hindi and Bengali Films. Apart from being a versatile composer, he also sang songs in the folk style of Tripura. His Son Rahul Dev Burman was also a famous music director.

Temperature and Rainfall: The annual average temperature of the district varies maximum 34.3°C to minimum 12.7°C and the average annual rainfall of the district is recorded 2551 mm.

Main Rivers: The Meghna, Gumti and Dakatia are the main rivers of this district.

Main Crops: The major agricultural crops of Comilla District are paddy, jute, wheat, mustard seed, sugarcane, onion, garlic, potato, sweet potato, chilly and ground nut.

Economic Situation: The economy of Comilla is mainly agro-based. Out of total 917,743 holding, 60.59% holdings were farms that produced varieties of crops, namely, local and HYV paddy, wheat, jute and sugarcane occupied 83.14%, 0.74%, 0.515 and 0.07% of total gross cropped area respectively. Various fruits like banana, jackfruit, guava, coconut etc. are grown. Fish of different species are abundant in this district. These are abundantly cultivated in big dighees and ponds and also varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributaries and creeks. Besides crops, rearing of livestock and poultry are also another source of household income. Non-farm economic activities

play vital role in economic development of comilla district. The following Table-1 shows the type and number of establishments together with persons engaged by activity in those establishments.

Flora and Fauna

Flora: Comilla is one of the eastern districts of the country. It has border with Tripura (India) and has some hilly areas to the east. The soil of the district is mainly formed of olive grey silty loam and dark grey silty loam which are very rich and fertile. The vast areas on both banks of the rivers of the district belong to the cultivators, continuously flooded almost every year and thus grow crops like rice, jute, sugarcane, wheat, pulses and oil seeds.

The only hill in this district is the Lalmai which is situated 5 miles to the west of Comilla. The range extends over 11 miles from north to south and is about 25 miles in circumference with a height of 150 feet in a few places. The average elevation of these hills would be 90 feet above the sea level. The highest peaks are Kalirbazar and Chandimura.

The Lalmai hill is thickly wooded and there are also dense jungles towards the south-west of the district, but the forests were unimportant and the revenue earnings from the forest produce is very negligible. The Lalmai hills were once densely wooded and an area near Kotbari had been earmarked as a forest belt, thought almost the whole of Lalmai hills have been cleared up and cultivation has been extended at the foot hills. The Kotbari range comprised three forest belts i.e. Comilla belt in Kotwali P.S. Rajeswar belt in Kotwali and Choudyagram P.S. and Belonea belt in Parshuram P.S. The whole forest of this region is classified as acquired one.

The trees naturally grow in the district are banyan (*Ficus benghalensis*) commonly known as the bat tree, the pipal or aswatha (*Ficus religiosa*) the neem (*Azadirachta indica*) the bel (*aegle Marmelos*), the fruit is eaten and used medicinally; the rana or petraj (*Aphanamixis polystachia*); black berry

(*Syzygium cumini*); the cotton free, and simul (*Bombax ceiba*) the mandar (*Erythrina ovalifolia*); the mango several species of palms, kadamba (*Anthocephalus cadamba*), gab (*Diospyros precatorius*) the juice of the fruit mixed with charcoal is used in calking boats; Jalpai (*Elaeocarpus tectorius*) the fruit is used in curries by the natives simul (*Bombax ceiba*), the karpas is used for stuffing mattresses and pillows, and has a silky appearance; jamun (*Euginea jambolana*) the fruit is used for stuffing mattresses and pillows, and has a silky appearance; jamun (*Euginea jambolana*) the fruit is eaten, the wood is hard and useful for building purpose; amli tentul (*Tamarindus indica*) the wood is hard and closely grained and the fruit is also used for seasoning food and the leaves medicinally; mango (*magnifera indica*) the mangoes of the district are not good. The wood is of an inferior quality, yet, owing to its being in abundance, it is much used; khejur or date palm (*Phoenix sylvestris*) is a valuable tree; the juice is extracted and made into gur; the leaves are made into mats, tal (*Borassus flabelli formis*-the wood is used for posts of houses and other building purposes, the leaves are used for making large fans; betelnut (*Areca catechu*) grows in clumps; and plantations are found abundantly towards the west and south to the country. Coconut or narkel are also grown abundantly throughout the district, in terms of utility, it is one of the most important members of the vegetables kingdom; bet Calamus, (various species) grows spontaneously all over the district; they are split and made into baskets and the weaker work. They are also used for binding and thatching. Several species of palms also grow, here.

There are a few timber trees of commercial value. The wood of tamarind and kul (*Aizyphus mauritiana*) is hard grained and of good quality. The amaltas is used for house and rough furniture. Jarul is used for boat building. In the marshes are found joloz shola (*Aeschynomene aspera*), sitalpati (*Phrynium dischotomum*) and similar other aquatic plants often cover large area. Although there is no organized forest area but some scattered indigenous timber trees include, sheel koroi (*Albizia procera*), garjan (*Dipterocarpus trubinatus*), jarul (*Lagerstroemia speciosa*) etc. are found in the district. However, various exotic trees like teak, (*Tectone Grandis*) Mahagoni, (*Swietenia macrophylla*) sissu, (*Dalbergia Sissoo*) etc. have been introduced as wayside trees as well as farm forestry.

Fauna: There is practically no wild animal in the district. About 100 years back, there were a good number of barking deer, leopard, tiger, wild hog and various species of wild cat. There is, at present, jackals in large number in the district and share with vulture and crows the duties of village scavenger. The mongooses are common, but there are few monkeys and squirrels to be seen. Bird life is luxuriant. Almost all varieties of birds that are seen all over Bangladesh are also commonly seen in Comilla. Fish eagles, kites and brilliantly coloured kingfishers are common. Most of the roadside trees in the village remain crowded with small birds, golden oriole, king crows, the crow, pheasant, Woodpeckers, sun-birds, sparrows, host of little fly-catchers and of course, the ubiquitous magpie. Nightfall, the air is resonant. With their glamour, and even later the silence is broken by the deep-toned hoot of the homed owl. The game birds of the district including jungle fowl, wild duck, teal, golden plover, and snipe, which offered fair sports in the winter months. In fact due to lack of organized forest and other natural calamities all kinds of carnivores and mammals are becoming rare in the district.

The inhabitants along the banks of the Meghna and other large rivers all live on more or less fishing, but only a few exclusively fishing communities appear to exist in the district and the fisheries are conducted in a very rude manner. The demand for fish being considerable, various modes of catching fish are practiced. When the lands are inundated during the rainy months, fish is very scarce and the poor resort to the ditches and swamps.

Many varieties of sea and fresh water fish are available in the district. Most of the supply comes from ponds and tanks, canals and low lying areas inundated by rain water. Popular varieties include the carp tribe (Cyprinidoes), ruhi (*Labeo ruhita*), catla (*catla catla*), mrigel (*Cirrhinus mrigala*) and kalabaush (*Labeo calbasu*). airh (*Mystus aor*), tengra (*Mystus vittatus*) of several types, magur (*Clarious batrachus*), singi (*Heteropnuestes fossilis*), boal (*Wallagonia attu*), gazer (*channa marulius*) and pabda (*Ompok pabda*) are available in abundance. Prawn and crabs are also found. Muralla, punti (*Barbus puntius*) khosha, bain abd Chela are small fish and are found all over the district in abundance.

Exotic fishes like grass carp (*Cteropharynagodon idella*), silver carp (*Hyphthalmichthys molitrix*), telapia (*Oreochromis mossambicus*), nilotica (*Oreochromis niloticus*), etc. have also been introduced for commercial piscicultures in ponds and tanks.

Concepts and Definitions

Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

Community

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza:** Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.

- iii) **Village:** Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) **Mahalla:** Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

Urban Area

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

i) **City Corporation:** It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.

ii) **Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

Agriculture holding

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

(a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.

(b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.

(c) **large:** Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

Non-farm holdings

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

Tenancy

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Agriculture work

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

Area under temporary crops

It is the land area planted to crops having growing cycle or length of life less than one year. These are the temporary crops such as paddy, wheat, jute, cotton, tobacco, sugarcane, pulses, oil seeds, potato, vegetables and other seasonal crops. A list of temporary crops for which data were collected separately was given in back page of "Tally Sheet". The minimum area recorded for a temporary crop was 0.01 acre. Area under temporary crops and temporary-crops net area are equivalents.

Area under permanent crops

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

Current fallow

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

Intensity of cropping

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

$$\text{Intensity of cropping} = \frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

Cereals

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

Pulses

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soyabean, sunflower and castor.

Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

Spices

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

Fuel crops

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
